

## Manufacturing Program Eligibility Guide

See Product Guide for complete OnePac eligibility guidelines.

Cannot have the following operations, or be in a building with: electroplating or woodworking.

No modifying, updating or refurbishing of finished products made by others.

If the applicant currently, or has previously, engaged in the sale or treatment of wood or wood products for fireproofing, they are not eligible.

Products can be excluded.

Ineligible products include: aerospace, aircraft or aviation, auto or truck parts critical to operation or safety of the vehicle,

military applications, maritime use, alarms, fire suppression equipment, medical/healthcare or biotechnology, safety equipment, athletic equipment, guns and ammunition, watercraft or floatation devices, chemical, finished construction, farm or industrial machinery & equipment, pressurized containers, structural metal or steel.

Ineligible manufacturing operations include an exposure to bio-hazardous and/or radioactive/nuclear materials or

foreign products that are sold, distributed or used in components.

Equipment Breakdown Coverage not included, but optional.

Maximum property values per building= \$5,000,000 for sprinklered buildings; \$2,000,000 for non-sprinklered
